

Use this checklist to verify camera positions, equipment coverage, footage retention, and FORS Silver / DVS compliance for utility and maintenance fleet vehicles.

1. Standard Camera Positions

- ☐ Forward-facing camera — cab roof or front bumper mount, full-width FOV
- ☐ Rear-facing camera — covers traffic management zone behind vehicle
- ☐ Nearside camera — covers crew on foot alongside vehicle
- ☐ Offside camera — offside blind zone coverage
- ☐ Cab interior (driver-facing) camera

2. Equipment-Specific Cameras

- ☐ Cherry picker / aerial platform: arm-mounted or platform-adjacent camera
Covers platform position, ascent/descent zone, overhead clearance
- ☐ Mounted drill rig: wide-angle camera covering drill entry zone
Activated when equipment in operation mode
- ☐ Cable/trench laying: rear camera covers cable draw-off point and trench alignment
- ☐ Equipment zone camera confirmed on dedicated MDVR channel

3. Live Traffic Zone — Rear and Nearside Coverage

- ☐ Rear camera continuously records traffic management zone during works
- ☐ Rear footage retained immediately after any near-miss or collision
- ☐ Nearside camera covers crew zone during vehicle repositioning moves
- ☐ Traffic management setup confirmed on forward footage from approach

4. FORS Silver v7 Compliance (Rigid HGV >7.5t)

- ☐ Nearside proximity sensor with audible alert fitted
- ☐ MOIS front detection system fitted — mandatory from January 2025
- ☐ Left-turn audible warning with night mute (23:30–07:00) fitted
- ☐ Reversing alarm fitted and operational

- ☐ DVS PSS fitted if vehicle >12t operating in Greater London
- ☐ FORS Silver certificate current — vehicle registration included

5. Footage Retention for Street Works Disputes

- ☐ Standard retention: minimum 30 days for all footage
- ☐ Pre-works forward footage retained as baseline condition record
- ☐ Post-works footage preserved immediately if complaint foreseeable
- ☐ Incident-triggered footage preserved immediately and held until resolved
- ☐ Legal proceedings: footage preserved indefinitely once claim notified
